

# 39-MILE YARD SALE VENDOR APPLICATION

## *Be a Vendor*

**LOCATION:** Lake Wales History Museum, 325 South Scenic Highway, Lake Wales, FL 33853

- Yard sale vendors are welcome to sell new and used goods and merchandise during the Ridge Scenic Highway's 39-Mile Yard Sale on Saturday, November 6, 2021 from 8 AM–3 PM.
- The Lake Wales History Museum will host vendors in the parking area of the museum, which is paved.
- It is \$25 for a 10' x 10' area for a yard sale space. Vendors may purchase multiple spaces. Tents, tables and chairs are the responsibility of the vendor. You must anchor your tent with weights.
- Payments for vendor fees are due with your required advanced registration by September 24, 2021. Fees are non-refundable. The event is rain or shine.
- All vendors and space assignments will be approved and made in the order your registration was received. It is first come, first served. We will do our best to accommodate your request, but do not guarantee specific booth placement.
- No electric, water or WIFI is provided in the parking area, but the museum will be open for participants to use the restroom.
- Vendors may set-up their booth anytime between 5 - 8 PM on Friday, November 5, 2021 or 6 - 8 AM on Saturday, November 6, 2021.
- Vendors must be open by 8 AM, and move all vehicles to the event parking area by 7:45 AM. Vehicles are NOT permitted to remain in the yard sale vendor area during the event.
- No smoking is allowed around vendor exhibit spaces.
- In the event the Lake Wales History Museum must cancel its participation in the 39-Mile Yard Sale for whatever reason, all fees will be refunded to the vendor. In the event a vendor must cancel his/her booth, all fees are non-refundable, but may be transferred to future events.
- All vendors are responsible for the removal of all materials and equipment on Saturday, November 6, 2021 from 3 - 5 PM. The museum is not responsible for removing any unwanted items or garbage. A dumpster is located in the event parking area to dispose of unwanted items and garbage.
- Vendors are not allowed to sell the following items. If a vendor is found trying to sell any of the following items, they will be immediately asked to leave the yard sale:
  - Drugs, drug paraphernalia, lude or sexually inappropriate materials, live animals, weapons, and alcoholic beverages.
